Writing

- -If your child is unable to write a sentence on their own, have them tell you what they want to write. Then, write the sentence down on the paper and have them copy the sentence you wrote.
- -If your child is able to write a sentence on their own, **CHALLENGE** them to write an additional 1-2 sentences.

Reading

- If your child is having a hard time with answering a question you asked them, give them a hint. For example, if you are asking them a who question, remind them that who means a person.
- When asking your child a question and they are having a difficult time answering, give them 2 choices (correct answer & something else from the passage).
- <u>Context Clues:</u> using information from the passage to find/ support your answer.
- <u>Predicting:</u> a guess you make based off of clues in a story.
- <u>Inferencing</u>: using clues from the story and what you already know to figure out what the author is trying to say.
