

## **Art IV Supply List**

(Most of these we have in the art room, but you may want personal supplies for at home)

- ebony drawing pencils and kneaded or mars white erasers
- personal coloring items –markers, colored pencils, crayons etc. fine black markers
- any other materials desired by the artist.
- Strongly encouraged—a personal sketchbook

**Optional:** A portfolio -preferably vinyl with handle. Michaels carries 3 sizes of them online.

Plan ahead before you buy. You will want your artwork to fit!



**Objective of class**—you will work on producing a portfolio that can either be used to present to a fine art or graphic design program at college, or can be used to take on a job interview in an art field, such as T-shirt design, graphics, advertising etc.

**Prerequisites for the class**— Students must have passed Art I, Art II, and Art III with averages of 90 or higher.
