You do not have to be a realistic sketch artist or a fine painter to get an "A" in art class. There are many types of art and many ways to create art. We will investigate the world of art and develop our skills as we go.

Each assignment will have a rubric and you should read it carefully. Following directions, work ethic, student habits, neatness, creative thought, and appropriate use of materials are some of the things I will look for when grading.

YOU have control of your grade.

Grading: Your art projects will earn grades based on the rubric that comes with the task. It is your responsibility to read all the criteria and follow the directions. Read carefully.

Final: To exempt the art final, you must have ALL assignments turned in, and meet grade and attendance criteria as decided upon by the school administration.

Art Expectations

Pay attention during instruction.

Work quietly, and only use your phone for music & research.
