NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The Butts County Board of Education will tentatively adopt a millage rate which will remain the same as the Fiscal Year 2020 millage rate of 15.96 mills; however, due to property reassessments, this will represent an average increase of 4.77% in property taxes..

All concerned citizens are invited to attend the public hearings on this tax increase to be held at the Butts County Schools Administrative Offices, 181 N. Mulberry Street, Jackson, GA on the following dates:

July 9, 2020 at 10:00 AM July 9, 2020 at 6:00 PM July 16, 2020 at 10:00 AM

The tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 15.96 mills, an increase of 0.727 mills over the rollback millage. The rollback millage rate is calculated to produce the same total revenue on the current year's digest that last year's millage rate would have produced had no reassessments occurred. Without this tentative tax increase, the rollback millage rate will be no more than 15.233 mills.

In setting the millage rate to support the budget, the Butts County Board of Education will keep the same total mill rate, the district will collect more taxes than in the previous year. Therefore, by law, this millage rate must be advertised as a property tax increase due to the higher value of property in the county.
