The Division's goal is to return children safely to their families as soon as possible, but only after the safety issues have been resolved. Foster care is intended to be a temporary home away from home while the agency works with the child's family to eliminate or minimize the safety issues that caused agency involvement.

A FEW REQUIREMENTS:

- 1.) Age 25+
- 2.) Pass a drug screen
- 3.) Complete a medical exam
- 4.) Valid Georgia Driver's License
- 5.) Meet home safety requirements
- 6.) Provide employment and family references
- 7.) Complete state and a federal background check
- 8.) Attend Orientation/IMPACT foster parent training program
