We are excited about the REACH Scholar Program for the Butts County School System 2021-2022 year. The acronym for REACH is <u>R</u>ealizing <u>E</u>ducational <u>A</u>chievement <u>Can Happen</u> Scholarship Program. We would like to extend this opportunity to rising 8th Grade students at Henderson Middle School. Below there is a criteria list of expectations for our students. If you feel that your child may benefit from this program, please have your child's name emailed to his or her homeroom teacher. Upon receiving the names your child may receive a detailed application that will need to be completed.

REACH SCHOLAR CRITERIA FOR STUDENTS;

- Academic Achievement Students must have the ability to earn at least a B average in their core classes.
- Attendance Students must have fewer than three excused absences.
- Discipline Students must have a <u>minimum of 0-3 Level 1</u> disciplinary infractions.
- **Process** Students and Parents must successfully complete all paperwork.
- Interview Students selected must complete an interviewing process done by a community selection committee.
- **Income** Parent incomes must meet the requirement for their child to be eligible for free or reduced lunch.
